Did you know?

- 29% of Maui County residents live and work in the same town
- 50% of Maui County workplace commuters travel for less than 20 minutes and 5% travel for more than one hour
- Just over 4% of Maui County residents walk or bike to work
- Less than 1% of Maui Nui uses public transportation
- Nearly three-quarters of Maui County workers drive to work alone\*
