GIVING ~ Maui Style



The distribution of nonprofits across the state is very even; however, when compared to the number of people living below the poverty line in each county, Maui outpaces the other counties.

The last comprehensive study of Hawai'i's household giving patterns found that Hawai'i's people are generous, there is a resiliency in Hawai'i's giving, and, yes indeed, the economy impacts giving. Whether feeding the hungry or helping homeless youth, providing needed housing and healthcare services or organizing community



civic engagement, Hawai'i has over 5,000 nonprofit organizations registered with the IRS. The economic contribution of Hawai'i's nonprofits is approximately \$3.8 billion each year, representing nearly eight percent of the state's gross domestic product — making Hawai'i's per capita spending well above the national level. For most nonprofits revenues come primarily from program service fees and contracts, then contributions, gifts and grants. Excepting 14 organizations with annual expenses of over \$50 million, all other organizations in Hawai'i's nonprofit sector have seen revenue increases of 32 percent since 2000.
