Where We Labor



In July 2009 Maui County's total wage and salaried workforce was down by 6.4% from one year ago.

Except for **government** and **health care & social assistance**, all other workforce categories in Maui County lost jobs over the last year, with the largest loss in **agriculture** which is down by 17.1%.

The largest number of current workers in Maui County is in **accommodations** with 10,600 workers (15.5%), followed closely by **government** with 9,750 (14.2%) jobs. Posting a strong third is **retail trade** with 9,350 (13.6%) positions.



Food service & drinking places with 7,350 (10.7%), **professional & business services** at 6,500 (9.5%), and **health care & social assistance** counting 5,050 (7.3%) comprise the middle range of job categories.



Maui County has 3,750 (5.4%) jobs in **natural resources, mining, construction, transportation, warehousing, utilities, 2,750 (4.0%) in other services, 2,450 (3.7%) in financial activities, and 2,000 (2.9%) in arts, entertainment & recreation.**



The fewest number of jobs in Maui County are in the categories of **agriculture** with 1,450 (2.1%), **wholesale trade** with 1,400 (2.0%), **manufacturing** with 1,100 (1.6%), **educational services** with 1,050 (1.5%), and **information** with 800 (1.1%).

Maui County's employed civilian workforce is 50.3% of the resident population.
